



CIVIC VOICES FELLOWSHIP



The Civic Voices Fellowship is designed for individuals looking to build power in their communities by building an engaged electorate through a program uniquely tailored to registering and mobilizing voters in underrepresented communities.

This fellowship is a stipended four-month program and will be the primary vehicle for carrying out important parts of a community and voter engagement outreach strategy in South King County. The three components of the fellowship will include work with a community organization, a voter registration drive at a designated college campus, and general outreach within the community.

- **College Campus Work** - The fellow will work to register and mobilize students to vote through a combination of tactics including, but not limited to class announcements, information tables, forums, ballot parties, and peer-to-peer texting.
- **Community Work** - The fellow will be responsible for participating in community events like farmers markets, festivals, or other public forums where they will provide voter registration and education. Additionally, the fellow will work with small businesses to promote voter education to customers and community members.
- **Work with Fuse Partners** - The fellow will support local organizations in partnership with Fuse by providing voter education and registration outreach resources.

Skills and Qualifications

The position includes significant leadership development, organizing training, and skills development. As such, the ideal candidate is new to organizing and social change work, has a strong racial justice analysis, and is passionate about the representation of communities.

This position will require trips to various parts of South King County and thus access to a vehicle and valid driver's license are recommended but not required. The fellow will need to be able to work some evenings and weekends.

Payment

All fellows will be stipended at \$750 per month for four months, working 12 hours a week.
